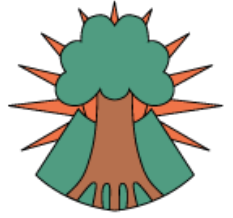

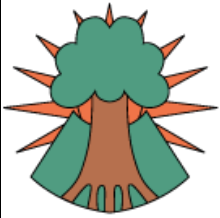

School Uniform

It is not compulsory to wear school uniform in the nursery - however most children do, it makes life easier for you parents!

Remember to label each item of clothing!!

The school uniform is available from [YC Sports](#) shop.

Many Supermarkets now sell school uniforms.

We suggest that your child wear comfortable trousers and 'velcro' shoes to help them dress independently.

The children will not need PE Kit - just comfortable clothes and running shoes. More information will be given in September.

You are welcome to send a bag with spare clothes, but we kindly ask that you do not send any toys.





HOW YOU CAN HELP YOUR CHILD?

- Encourage your child to use the toilet independently.
- Teach your child to wash his/her hands and reinforce this regularly so that he/she always remembers doing so.
- Teach your child to put his/her coat on independently.
- Encourage your child to tidy up and look after toys.
- Encourage your child to blow/dry nose independently
- If your child is using a dummy or bottle, I would encourage you to remove this as soon as possible, this can affect the development of children's language.

In addition, we would appreciate it if you could:

- Talk to your child about the fun they have had in school by looking at SeeSaw photos - login information will follow in September.
- help your child recognise their name
- read books and watch Welsh programs with your child as often as possible (Cyw / Welsh Apps)
- Give your child the opportunity to use creative equipment at home e.g. crayons, pencils, paper, glue, scissors and paint

Healthy Snack & Milk



Children receive a healthy snack and milk or water daily. We kindly ask you to contribute £ 1 a week towards this.

Please pay in advance, either half term or termly, we ask you to place it in an envelope with your child's name. We will be sending out more details in September.

IMPORTANT - If your child has any allergies, it MUST be reported on the first day!



Medication / Accidents

We do not have the right to administer any medicines such as Calpol, Nurofen etc which do not have a Doctor's prescription. If your child needs medication from a Doctor you will need to complete a medication form which is available from the office.

If your child falls / is injured we will fill in an accident form and let you know. If your child has a bump to the head, we will call you immediately to discuss.

Your child's first day at school is to treasure and we will make every effort to make it a happy and memorable one for everyone.

Nursery children start in small groups, to give them the opportunity to settle in and get used to new faces as well as their new learning environment. It will also be a valuable opportunity for parents and staff to get to know each other. We kindly ask that you escort your child to the main entrance of the Nursery on New Zealand Road where the Nursery teacher will be there to greet and help you.

The class teacher, along with the classroom assistant, will be available to guide your child into the classroom. There, a variety of engaging activities will be prepared, and the children will have easy access to play and wander around the classroom during their first session.

We ask that you say goodbye to your child in a happy manner. Some children are likely to be tearful when parents first leave them, but they soon get used to saying goodbye. If we feel that your child is still upset after a period of time, we will contact you.

When you collect your child at the end of the session, we ask that you wait outside the Nursery entrance gates. We will transfer children safely to their parent / guardian individually.

REMEMBER to let the staff know if a different person will be collecting your child, whether by phone or verbally. We will not allow a child to go home with any people we do not recognise.
