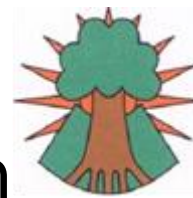

Whilst it has been pleasing that the roll out of the vaccine has enabled schools to remain open to a larger extent than last year, the pandemic has still continued to be disruptive in many ways.

Rwy'n gwybod bod fy Nghyd-lywodraethwyr yn gytun â mi wrth ddweud bod y disgyblion wedi gadael argraff fawr arnom pan gawsom y cyfle i siarad â hwy. Eleni gan na allwn gyfarfod â'r disgyblion yn yr ysgol yn bersonol, cafwyd cyfarfodydd arlein gyda Chyngor yr ysgol a'r holl bwyllgorau eraill trwy gyfres o gyfarfodydd timau. Fel yn y blynyddoedd blaenorol cafodd eu brwdfrydedd a'u sgwrsio difyr argraff fawr arnom ac roedd yn amlwg eu bod yn datblygu i fod yn ddinasyddion ifanc gydag ymwybyddiaeth a gwerthfawrogiad o faterion pwysig i'n cymdeithas. Credaf hefyd y gall ein Harweinwyr Ddigidol fy addysgu i llawer am Dechnoleg Gwybodaeth!

Yn anffodus, mae'n anochel i'r pandemig effeithio y clybiau a'r gweithgareddau allgyrsiol a gynigwyd gan yr ysgol. Fodd bynnag, fel yr amlinellir yn yr adroddiad hwn, ceisiodd yr ysgol ddarparu cyfleoedd ychwanegol i'r disgyblion lle bynnag y bu'r modd a'r gobaidh yw y parheir i gynnig mwy a mwy o'r cyfleoedd hyn maes o law, gan gynnwys adeiladu ar gysylltiadau â'r gymuned leol. Gwn fod yr ysgol yn gweld hyn fel rhan hanfodol i helpu ein disgyblion i ddatblygu'n unigolion iach, hapus a chyflawn.

Mae'r ysgol wedi cario ymlaen i baratoi o ddifrif ar gyfer y Cwricwlwm ysgol newydd yng Nghymru a ddaw i rym yn 2022. Arweinir hyn at newidiadau yn yr addysgu ac fel y disgwylir, creu her enfawr i Miss Evans a'i staff wrth baratoi at hyn. Un rhan o'r gwaith llywodraethu yw gweithredu fel 'ffrind beirniadol' ac yn ein trafodaethau â Miss Evans ac aelodau eraill o'r

In addition to teaching throughout a further national lockdown and closing all schools for the majority of the Spring Term, the teachers have had to juggle teaching pupils in a classroom with other children isolating at home, or even having to teach from home while having to isolate themselves. In my view, they have shown tremendous resilience and an ability to adapt (on an almost daily basis at times), and it's clear that their priority throughout has been the education and welfare of all the pupils.

We also recognise how difficult this last year has continued to be for families, and would like to thank all parents and guardians for their support, hard work and determination.

Credit must also go to the pupils, who themselves have had to adapt to the measures and change in routines. Following the periods of school closure, it has been wonderful to see and hear the children playing on the playground again!

I know I speak for all my fellow-governors when I say that we continue to be hugely impressed by the pupils when we get opportunities to speak with them. This year, in the absence of being able to meet with pupils at the school in person, we met with the School Council and all the other committees via a series of Teams meetings. As in previous years, we were impressed by how engaged they all were and how well they spoke, and it was clear that they are developing into young citizens with an awareness and appreciation of important societal issues. I also think that our Digital Leaders could teach me a lot about I.T.!

Unfortunately, the pandemic has inevitably impacted upon the extracurricular clubs and activities that the school is able to offer. However, the school has sought to provide additional opportunities to the pupils wherever possible, as outlined in this report, and it is hoped that opportunities to do this further will increase in due course, including building upon links with our local community. I know that the school sees this as a crucial part of helping our pupils to develop into healthy, happy and well-rounded individuals.

The school has continued in earnest with its preparation for the new school curriculum in Wales, which is due to come into effect in 2022. This will lead to a radical change in the way that children in Wales are educated and, as you would expect, this presents a huge challenge to

We are unpaid volunteers, who have received statutory training, and much of our work goes on outside the public eye, so I would like to take this opportunity to thank our Vice-Chair, Jenny Williams, and other fellow governors for their dedication, time and commitment for the benefit of all pupils and the continuous improvement of the school.

What is a Governor?

Mae llywodraethwr yn rhywun sydd:-

- Yn wirfoddolwr;
- Yn poeni am addysgu, dysgu a phlant;
- Yn cynrychioli pobl gyda diddordeb allweddol yn yr ysgol, yn cynnwys rhieni, staff, y gymuned leol a'r AALI;
- Yn aelod o dîm sy'n derbyn cyfrifoldeb am bopeth y mae ysgol yn ei wneud;
- Ag amser i'w roi i gyfarfodydd a digwyddiadau eraill pan fo angen;
- Yn fodlon dysgu;
- Yn gallu bod yn ffrind sy'n cefnogi'r ysgol ond sydd hefyd yn gallu cadw golwg feirniadol ar sut y mae'r ysgol yn gweithio ac ar y safonau a gyflawnir;
- Yn ddolen gyswllt rhwng rhieni, y gymuned leol, yr AALI a'r ysgol.

Cynhelir cyfarfod o'r Corff Llywodraethol o leiaf unwaith y tymor a threfnir cyfarfodydd ychwanegol o'r is-bwyllgorau yn dymhorol neu yn fwy aml yn ôl y galw. Mae gan bob llywodraethwr hefyd ddiddordeb pynciol arbennig, a gall ymweld â'r ysgol neu sgwrsio gyda'r athro sy'n gydlynedd pwnc er mwyn deall a chefnogi'r addysg.

Beth yn union mae Llywodraethwyr yn ei wneud?

1. Cytuno ar amcanion a gwerthoedd yr ysgol
2. Cytuno ar bolisiau yn ymwneud â nodau, dibenion ac ymarferion yr ysgol
3. Dylanwadu ar a chymeradwyo Cynllun Gwella Ysgol a monitro dyraniad a gwariant cyllideb yr ysgol
4. Sicrhau bod y cwricwlwm cenedlaethol yn cael ei ddysgu a bod digon o staff ar gael i'w ddysgu
5. Monitro ac adolygu cynnydd yr ysgol

A governor is someone who:-

- Is a volunteer;
- Cares about teaching, learning and children;
- Represents those people with a key interest in the school, including parents, staff, the local community and the LEA;
- Is part of a team which accepts responsibility for everything a school does;
- Has time to commit to meetings and other occasions when needed;
- Is willing to learn;
- Is able to act as a friend who supports the school but is still able to cast a critical eye upon how the school works and the standard it achieves;
- Acts as a link between parents, the local community, the LEA and the school.

The Governing Body meets at least once a term and additional sub-committee meetings are held every term or more frequently as necessary. Each governor also has a subject area of interest, and he/she can visit the school or discuss with the teacher subject co-ordinator in order to understand and support the way that subject is taught.

What exactly do Governors do?

1. Agree the aims and values of the school
2. Agree policies relating to the aims, purposes and practices of the school
3. Influence and approve the School Improvement and monitor the allocation and expenditure of the budget
4. Make sure the national curriculum is taught and there is sufficient staff to teach it

Mae gan yr ysgol strategaeth sy'n cynnwys cylchlythyru rhieni/gwarcheidwaid yn gyson ynglŷn â lefelau presenoldeb plant. Mae'r ysgol yn cydweithio'n agos gyda'r Swyddog Presenoldeb, os yw'r ysgol yn pryderu am absenoldeb plentyn yna mae'r Swyddog Presenoldeb yn cysylltu gyda'r teulu i drafod ac i gynnig cymorth. Ein targed fel ysgol yw presenoldeb o dros 96.3%.

Hysbysiad Cosb Benodedig

Mewn rhai amgylchiadau, bydd yr ysgol efallai yn gofyn bod y Gwasanaeth Lles Addysg i gyhoeddi rybudd o Hysbysiad Cosb Benodedig o dan y Rheoliadau Addysg (Hysbysiadau Cosb) (Cymru) 2013 i rieni / warcheidwaid. Bydd llythyr o rybudd yn cael ei ddanfôn os:

- Mae rhieni / warcheidwaid wedi methu cymryd rhan mewn ymdrechion i wella presenoldeb;
- Mae'r heddlu wedi dod o hyd i ddisgybl yn rheolaidd o fod yn absennol o'r ysgol heb reswm derbyniol.

This school has a strategy which includes corresponding with parents/guardians on a regular basis regarding children's attendance levels. The school works closely with the Attendance Officer. If the school has a concern over the absence of a pupil, the Attendance Officer will work with the family offering them support and guidance. Our school target for attendance is over 96.3%.

Fixed Penalty Notices

In some circumstances, the school may request the Educational Welfare Service to issue parents/carers with a Fixed Penalty Notice under the Education (Penalty Notices) (Wales) Regulations 2013. A warning letter will be sent first if:

- There have been 10 unauthorised sessions within one school term;
- A child has been late (after registration has closed) on 10 occasions within one school term;
- Parents/carers have failed to engage in attempts to improve attendance;
- The police have regularly found a pupil to be absent from school without an acceptable reason.

A Fixed Penalty Notice will be issued if:
